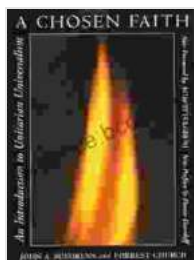


Chosen Faith: An Introduction to Unitarian Universalism

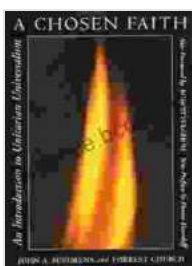

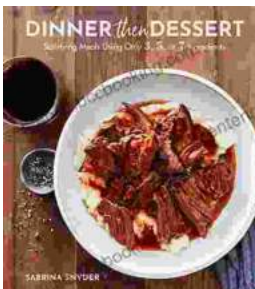

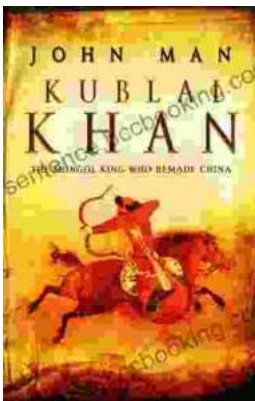
