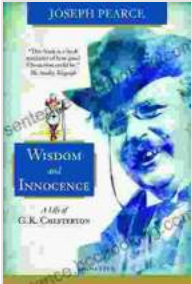

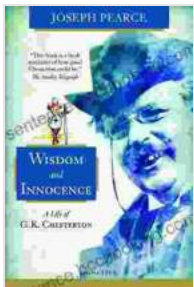

"atmosphere" is a mere piece of scientific & enlightened psychology. There
is no serious educator in Europe who would deny the moral shock of
taking a child from one religious environment to another. And I should have
thought that anyone who had so much as seen an Irish parent (even in the distance)
could know what he would say in answer to Mrs Montefiore or another, if
they promised not to violate the Catholicism of a little boy or girl. He would
say: "But Mrs Montefiore would not know when she was violating Catholicism.
Catholicism is not a topic. It is not something one can mention on Tuesday
but not on Friday. It is a way of looking at everything that is in the world."
I do not know how far Mr Keble yielded to this unbecomingly modernist opinion.
But if he did agree to it, I am certain he would have been about as wise
if he had tried to alter the great national song that commemorates the
murder of his grandfather, into a song beginning: "Evolution save Ireland!"

There is only one other moral sheet a very important one: the instant
necessity of Home Rule. To know she is right or wrong, the Nationists
are ~~as~~ as thoroughly proved right as the Internationalists are proved
wrong. ~~English~~ I believe ~~that~~ there is a section in the Suffrage
Movement called Spiritual Militants. I don't know what they do. Perhaps the
brown trousers not made with hands. Perhaps they fight with the provincial
police when they are on the spot. But in any case, I am quite sure that you
& I ought to be spiritual Home Rulers. I mean that we ought to keep
~~our hands off the printing we have made for so many years & mean~~
~~that the English ought not to get of us with the Irish~~ I mean they do
ought to respect the dignity which is the dignity of Ireland & that
it should be written up in large letters: "No English Head Office." Especially
when they are not English.



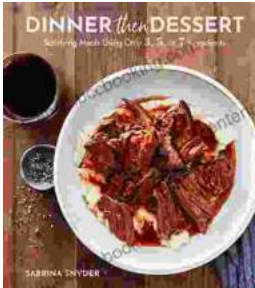

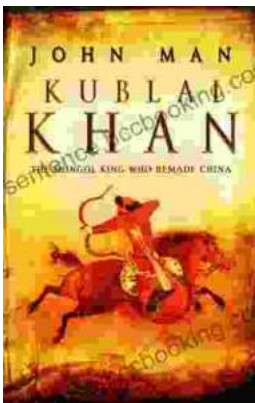
