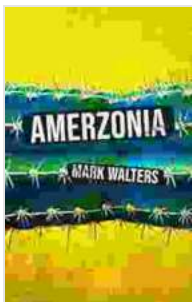


# Savage Journey Through the Americas: From Los Angeles to the Amazon - Gonzo Travel

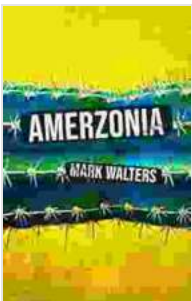

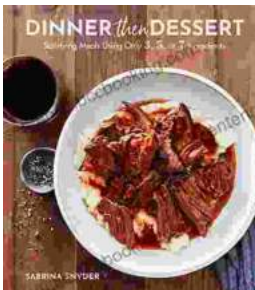

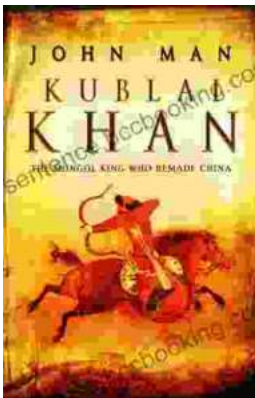
