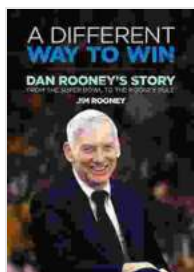


The Dan Rooney Story: From the Super Bowl to the Rooney Rule

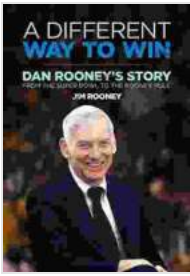

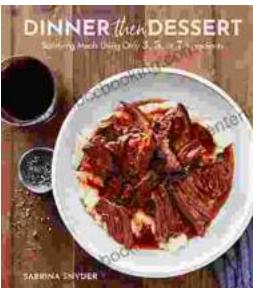

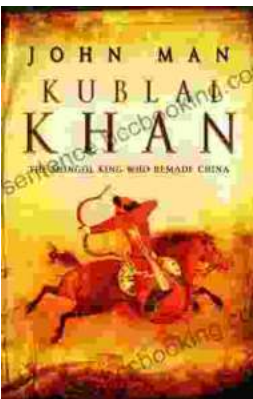
