

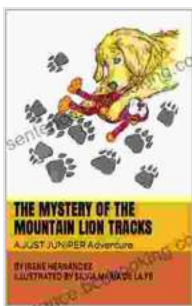
The Mystery Of The Mountain Lion Tracks : A JUST JUNIPER Adventure (JUST JUNIPER Adventures Chapter 2)

Chapter 5: The Battle with Maldred

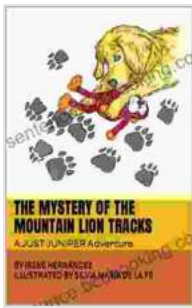
Juniper and Maldred fought a fierce battle. Maldred was a powerful sorcerer, but Juniper was determined to defeat him.

The forest came back to life. The animals were healed, and the plants began to grow again.

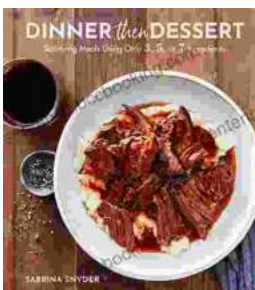
Juniper had saved the forest, and she was hailed as a hero.

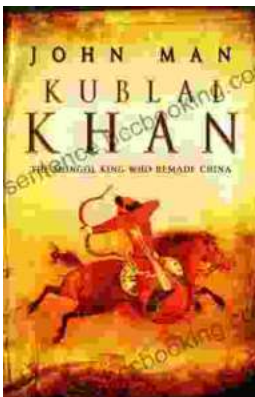
